Guidelines:

- Original posters must be submitted on **white 8 ½" x 11" paper or poster board of that size.**
- Any non-smearable medium is acceptable such as colored pencils, markers, crayons, paints, etc.
- A separate category for original computer generated art has been included, which should be submitted as a color printout. Students must own all rights to reproduce photos and images they utilize in developing the **computer generated** poster.
- No loose or hanging materials permitted.
- A **one paragraph statement describing how the poster reflects the theme** is required to be affixed to the back of the poster along with the student's name, telephone and address, age, grade level, parents' names, as well as the school address, teacher's first and last name and county, along with a Law Week poster registration form.
- All entries should be postmarked no later than **Friday, March 5, 2010** and submitted to:
