Postmark Deadline: Friday, March 27, 2026

Guidelines:

- Original posters must be submitted on white 8 1/2" x 11" paper or poster board of that size.
- Any permanent medium is acceptable such as colored pencils, markers, crayons, paints.
- No loose or hanging materials permitted.
- A one-paragraph statement describing how the poster reflects the theme is required to be affixed to the back of the poster along with the student's full name, telephone and address, age, grade level, parents' names, as well as the school name and address, teacher's full name and class along with a Law Week poster registration form.
- All entries should be postmarked no later than Friday, March 27, 2026, and submitted to:
